**Former Labour Worker's Death.-** Mrs Catherine Way, aged 87, of 24 Hearn Street, died at St. Mary's Hospital on Friday week. A native of the Island, Mrs. Way, formerly Miss Catherine Morey, was the widow of Mr. H. Way, local secretary of the millers' branch of the Transport and General Workers' Union. Mrs. Way was particularly active in connection with the Labour and Co-operative movements. She was a member of the board of management of the Cowes Co-operative Society for 22 years, and was a former president and secretary of the Women's Co-operative Guild. She had also been vice-president of the Isle of Wight Divisional Labour party and president of the Transport and General Workers' Women's Guild. Since her husband's death, she had resided with her daughter. The funeral took place on Wednesday at Newport Cemetery, the Rev. L. J. D. Wheatley officiating. The mourners were Messrs. R. J. Dore and F. Benfield (sons-in-law), Mr. R. B. Dore (grandson), and Messrs. A. K. Adams and R. Early (nephews). Interment was in her husband's grave. Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son made the arrangements.
