Death of Mrs. Arthur Wood.- The death occurred at her residence, Westward Ho, Cypress-road, on Saturday, at the age of 82, of Mrs. Fanny Wood, widow of Mr. Arthur Wood, of Newport House, the former proprietor of the ironmongery and agricultural implement business in Pyle-street, who died six years ago. Since the death of her husband Mrs. Wood had been cared for by her two daughters, the Misses A. and L. Wood, and she passed away after only a few days' illness, although she had been confined to her room for about a year. At one time Mrs. Wood took a keen interest in the I.W. Horticultural Association and the Primrose League. She was a native of Hereford and came to Newport on her marriage about 55 years ago. The funeral took place on Tuesday, the Rev. E. M. Ellis (curate) officiating at the service in the Parish Church and the interment in Newport Cemetery. The family mourners were Messrs. A. J. and E. W. Wood (sons), the Misses A. M. and L.
