Died on Holiday Visit. — A native of the Island, Mrs. Margaret Annie Woolnough, who, since her marriage, had been returning every year for a holiday, died suddenly on Thursday week at 19 Union Street, aged 73. Mrs. Woolnough, who had been living at Kingston-on-Thames, came to the town three weeks ago with her husband for their annual holiday, staying as usual with Mrs. Urry in Union Street. She was taken ill after paying a visit to friends in Lake, where she was born, being a daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. George Cassford. She married her husband when he was on the clerical staff of Parkhurst Prison. On his promotion, she went with him to Preston, Shrewsbury, Maidstone, Brixton, and Chelmsford, and, on his retirement from the position of prison steward 19 years ago, went to Kingston-on-Thames. The funeral service on Monday at the Parish Church was conducted by the Vicar (the Rev. C. R. Farnsworth) and the interment was at Fairlee Cemetery. The floral tributes included one from neighbours in Beresford Road, Kingston-on-Thames. Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son made the arrangements.
