**Nonagenarian's Death.** – A well known figure in the town has been removed by the death on Thursday morning, of Mr. Henry William Adams at the age of 91. He passed away at the residence of his son at 78 Alexandra-terrace. Mr. Adams was in business as a pork butcher in Pyle-street and Upper St. James's-street many years ago. He was also associated with the mineral water manufacturing firm Fianders, and later purchased several agricultural holdings around Newport, and himself farmed Little Pan for a time. He enjoyed remarkably good health, and was wonderfully active until a few months before his death. The funeral will take place to-day (Saturday), the interment being at Newport Cemetery following a service at the Baptist Church.
