DEATH FROM SLEEPING SICKNESS. — The death occurred at the County Hospital on Wednesday of Clara Marjorie Andrews, aged 12, daughter of Mr. L. Andrews, of Orchard-street. Whilst attending the Newport Council Schools just before Christmas the deceased was attacked with a mysterious illness, which affected the brain and caused great drowsiness, and which was eventually diagnosed as encephalitis lethargica (sleeping sickness). In spite of everything that could be done for her at the hospital she gradually sank and died. She was a bright and popular scholar, both of the Nodehill School and the St. John's Sunday school, and took a leading part in the children's opening of the St. John's bazaar in November, and would have had a place in the school entertainment at Christmas, when although not well enough to perform she had her wish to witness the entertainment gratified. This is believed to be the first and only case of the kind reported in the Island. Much sympathy is felt with the parents.
