NEWPORT.

THE FUNERAL – took place on Monday of Mr. Richard Bennett, of 74 Caesars-road, for nearly half a century the gardener at Bellecroft, Staplers, until some 11 years ago, when he retired on pension, granted by the family of the late Mr. William Major Cooke. The first part of the service was at St. John's Church, the Vicar (Rev. W. H. Mackinnon) officiating, and the interment was at Newport Cemetery. The principal mourners were Mrs. Bennett (daughter-in-law), Sidney and Roy Bennett (grandsons), Mr. C. Morgan (representing the family of deceased's late employers at Bellecroft), Messrs. H. Prouten, Isaac Salter, Hookey, Colborne, and A. E. Cave, Mrs. Daish, and others. There were floral tributes from the daughter-in-law and grandsons, Sir Henry and Lady Paget Cooke, Mr. Sidney and Miss P. Russell Cooke, Miss Cooke (Ryde), Mr. and Mrs. Corrie, Mr. Darrell Cooke, Mrs. Brown, Mr. Dove (Hearn-street), Mr. and Mrs. Marshall and family (Kent), and Mr. and Mrs. Daish.
