NEWPORT.

The Late Mr. R. H. Brimson. – The death occurred on Sunday of Mr. Ronald Harvie Brimson, of Enden, Carisbrooke-road, aged 44. Mr. Brimson had assisted his father (Mr. R. Brimson) in a decorating business, but on the outbreak of war, he became a fitter at Messrs. J. S. White and Co.'s Somerton works. He was a member of the Carisbrooke branch of Toc H and took a keen interest in the Newport Victoria Sports Club. He leaves a widow, son, and a daughter, with whom much sympathy is felt. The funeral was on Thursday, the service being held at the Congregational Church. The Rev. T. E. R. Langridge officiated, and the hymn "Abide with me" was sung. The mourners were Messrs. R.
