DEATH OF MR. G. W. BROOKS. - The death occurred at Southsea, on Thursday week, of Mr. Gilbert Whalley Brooks, who until recently resided at Terrace-road. The deceased, who was over 70 years of age, was a very well known resident of the town. He was a scholar at the Grammar School with the late Sir Frederick Black, K.C.B., under the head-mastership of the late Rev. E. W. Watts, M.A. The funeral took place at the Parish Church on Wednesday, the Vicar (the Rev. J. F. S. Glynn) officiating. The interment followed at Newport Cemetery, where the deceased was laid with other members of the family. The flag of the Conservative Club, of which deceased was a member, was flown at half-mast.
