Death of Mr. Walter Brown.—The death took place on Tuesday at his residence, Binstead House, Pyle-street, of Mr. Walter Brown, aged 78, who will be remembered as a prominent cattle dealer of former days, well known and respected in the Island and at the leading markets in the South of England. In his early days he lived at Hunnyhill and then removed to Kitbridge Farm, from which he retired only a few years ago. He was for some years a partner with the late Mr. Charles Allen, of Horringford, in a thriving cattle dealers' business, and afterwards traded on his own account for some years. Of a cheery and kindly disposition, he had many friends, and he was a valued supporter of the work of the Salvation Army in Newport from its commencement and also of the United Methodist Church. The sympathy of a wide circle of friends will be with the bereaved widow and family in their loss. The deceased celebrated his golden wedding seven years ago. The funeral took place yesterday (Friday) afternoon, the first part of the service being held at the United Methodist Church, where there was a considerable attendance, and the interment was at the Newport Cemetery. The Rev. P. Cudmore, who officiated, assisted by Adjutant Cox, of the Salvation Army, spoke on the traits of deceased's Christian character, reverence, resignation, and rejoicing. The personal mourners were Messrs, George, David, Herbert, and Samuel Brown (sons), G. H. Yelf, T.C., F. Trim, and E. Ash (sons-in-law), Herbert, Walter, Horace, and Samuel Lower, Masters Harold Brown, Harold Ash, Victor Yelf, and Leslie Chant (grandsons), Messrs. W. and H. Brown (Dunsbury), P. and C.
