DEATH OF MR. A. E. CAVE. – We regret to record the death of a highly-esteemed townsman in the person of Mr. Albert Edward Cave, 77, of the Newport Nurseries, which took place at the County Hospital, following an operation. Deceased had been in delicate health for some time, but was able to get out until comparatively recently. His late father, whom he succeeded in the nursery business, took over the Newport Nurseries, the oldest establishment of the kind in the Island, from the late Mr. William Wilkins in 1865, and he was a skilled member of his profession, a member of the Royal Horticultural Society, and one of the oldest members of the I.W. Horticultural Association, and highly respected in horticultural circles. He was also a valued worker, and for some years sidesman, of the Parish Church, and was a member of the old St. Thomas's Men's Bible Class. He was one of the oldest members of the Earl Yarborough Lodge of Oddfellows, and of the Literary Society. The funeral takes place this (Saturday) afternoon. The first part of the service will be held at the Parish Church at 2 o'clock.
