A CHILD ACCIDENTALLY DROWNED. - Mr. E. F. Blake, deputy coroner, held an inquest at the Salisbury Arms, on Saturday, on view of the body of Albert Stuart Cave, aged 2 years, son of Mr. Albert Cave, who resides in a cottage at the Newport Nursery Grounds, near Pan Bridge. It appeared in evidence that on Friday, about 4 p.m. deceased's mother looked into the kitchen where he had been left playing with two other children, and missed him, and shortly afterwards deceased's dead body was found in the mill-stream which runs close by the nursery grounds. - Verdict - "Accidentally drowned."
