WILLIAM COOKE. – We regret to record the death of an old and esteemed tradesman in the person of Mr. William Cooke, aged 73, of St. Thomas's-square, which sad event took place on Wednesday at the County Hospital, whither he had gone for a serious operation, which, unfortunately, it was found that he was too weak to undergo. The deceased was one of the oldest members of the Castlehold Baptist Church and a valued member and officer of the P.S.A., having been for many years the devoted registrar and treasurer of the Helping Hand Fund. He was also a member of the Liberal Club committee. Years ago he played in the old Town Band.
