### Hampshire Telegraph - 14 June 1862

#### NEWPORT.

A very sudden death occurred in Holyrood-street, on Tuesday morning, when Mr. James Cooper, tailor, was attacked with a fit whilst at work on his shopboard, and expired before medical aid could be rendered available. Deceased was a very industrious workman, and has left a widow and nine children to lament their loss. An inquest was held at the Town-hall on Wednesday before F. Blake, Esq., when the opinion of E. Bucknell, Esq., surgeon, was given that deceased had died of a disease of the heart, and the jury returned a verdict of "Died from Natural Causes."
