**DEATH OF MR. CHARLES COOPER.** – A familiar figure in the business life of the town has been removed by the death of Mr. Charles Cooper, fish salesman, of Upper Pyle-street, who passed away on Sunday after a long illness, at the age of 61. The deceased, who came to the Island from Jersey nearly 50 years ago, had been in business here for nearly 40 years, his chief lines being crabs, lobsters, oysters, and other shell fish, which he regularly obtained from Island fisherman. The funeral took place at Newport Cemetery on Wednesday, the chief mourners being his sister (Mrs. Duffy), who had cared for him during his long illness.
