Death of a Well-know Freemason – We regret to announce that on Friday, the 28th ultimo, Mr. Henry Sarel Cooper died at his residence in Holyrood-street, at the age of 76 years. He was during his life an energetic worker in Freemasonry, but for the last few years he was prevented, by failing health, from taking that active part which he had formerly done in the affairs of the craft. The deceased, who was highly respected by the many friends whom he had made in Newport, was interred at the Newport Cemetery on Thursday, the chief mourners being Mr. Supt. Blackwell (son-in-law), Henry Cooper Blackwell (grandson), and Messrs. T. and G. Sarel (cousins of the deceased). A number of members of the Albany Lodge of Freemasons also attended. The funeral service was impressively performed by Bro. the Rev. R. S. Wood. The deceased was a member of the following Lodges: Zetland, Imperial, South Middlesex, Industry, and United Strength, P.M., (the Mother Lodge). He was the founder of the three first-named Lodges, and he was also a Companion of Mount Sinai, Jerusalem, Lily of Richmond, and Albany Chapters: and a Mark Master of the Thistle Lodge, and Life Governor to the Girls' and Boys' Schools
