DEATH OF MR. RONALD CROUCHER B.Sc.

The death occurred very suddenly at Bromley, Kent, on Tuesday, at the age of 54, of Mr. Ronald Croucher, youngest son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Ernest Croucher, of Fairlee Road, and brother of the late Mr. S. V. Croucher, J.P., T.C. Mr. Croucher was an old boy of the County Secondary Grammar School and gained his B.Sc. degree at London University. For some years he had been principal of a private school at Bromley. Like his late brother he was a cricketer in his younger days, paying for the Newport C.C., and was also a keen student of politics. He had often spoken on behalf of the Conservative party in the Island, was chairman of the Conservative Association at Bromley, a member of the Central Council of the National Union of Conservative Associations, and had often taken part in debates at the Conservative Conference.
