Mr. Arthur Dockrill's Bereavement.- The deepest sympathy of his many friends in the borough and throughout the Island goes out to Mr. Arthur H. Dockerill, of Broadlands, Staplers Road, senior partner in the firm of Sir Francis Pittis and Son, auctioneers, in the unexpected death of his wife, which occurred at the Holmwood Nursing Home, Cowes, on Tuesday, after she had been suddenly taken ill at her home the previous day. Mr. and Mrs. Dockrill had been married 55 years. Mrs. Dockerill, a lady of much charm and kindliness, had devoted her life to her home and family, but during the last war was a valued worker at the War Hospital Supply Depot at Halberry House. She leaves one son, Lt.-Col. A. D. Dockerill, who is also a member of the firm of Sir Francis Pittis and Son, and one daughter. The funeral service will be at St, Paul's Church, Barton, to-day at 2 p.m.
