THE FUNERAL – took place on Saturday of Mr. David Dockrill, one of Newport's oldest and most respected residents, who passed away at the ripe age of 81 on the previous Wednesday at 18 Hearn-street, where he had resided for over 20 years. He was for many years principal warder at H.M. Convict Prison, Parkhurst, from which position he retired on pension in August 1891. The Rev. J. L. Spratt officiated at the service, the first part of which took place at the Parish-church and the interment was at Newport cemetery. The mourners were Mr. James Dockrill and Mr. Arthur H. Dockrill (sons), Mr. A. D. Dockrill (grandson), and Mr. John Norris.
