Death of A.R.P. Officer.—The death occurred on Thursday week at his residence, 34 Prospect-road, of Mr. Arthur Gallop, aged 53, who had been full-time equipment officer and storekeeper for the Newport district of A.R.P. Mr. Gallop served in the last war, and was a member of the British Legion. He leaves one son serving in the B.L.A and one with the R.A.F. in India. He also leaves two small sons and two daughters. He lost one son in the Navy. The funeral took place on Tuesday in the Parish Church, the Vicar (Canon W. B. Hogg) officiating. The family mourners were: Misses Mary and Violet Gallop (daughters), Master Harold Gallop (son), Mrs. F. Gallop and Mrs. W. Gallop (daughters-in-law), Mesdames H. Creese, E. Knight, A. Groves, G. Prouten, W. Hunnybun, and H. Jones (sisters), Mr. E. Gallop (brother), Mrs. E. Gallop and Miss E. Batchelor (sisters-in-law), Mr. W. Honeybun and Mr. H. Jones (brothers-in-law), and Mr. G. Batchelor and Mr. G. Prouten (nephews). His sons, Messrs. William and Desmond Gallop, were unable to attend owing to service abroad with the B.L.A. and the R.A.F. Others present included Commander E. D. L. Brown (county A.R.P. officer), representing Mr. P. E. White (county controller), and Messrs. K. W. Johnston (former A.R.P. officer), G. F. Tomlinson (county A.R.P. officer), H. E. Maynard (county A.R.P. equipment officer), F. B. Abraham (head warden,, Newport district), C. Golding (A.R.P. officer), W. O'Flaherty, H. James, and C. O. Sprake (Pan No. 1 post), J. R. Toogood (works superintendent, Newport Corporation), E. F. Millgate, A. E. Glassonbury, and H. Harvey (British Legion), and A. J. A. Harris (county highways surveyor), and Mrs. L. Ash. Messrs. Scott Whittington, Cottell and Bromwell (Civil Defense) acted as bearers, and members of the Newport Rescue Party met the cortege at Fairlee cemetery. Mr. H. W. Parnell made the arrangements.
