DR. HUTTON CASTLE'S BEREAVEMENT. - Very great sympathy is felt in the town for Dr. Hutton Castle, who sustained a heavy and unexpected bereavement by the death on Sunday of his only daughter, Mrs. H. A. C. Gardner. Mrs. Gardner was taken ill during the voyage home from Singapore, where her husband is an officer in the R.A.S.C. She was in a critical condition when the vessel arrived in London and was removed to hospital, but complications ensued and she passed away on Sunday. Mrs. Gardner, who was 34 years of age, had many friends in the Island who much deplore her early death. She leaves two children, a boy and a girl. Her remains were cremated and the ashes were buried at Newport Cemetery yesterday (Friday) afternoon, the Vicar (Canon C. H. Thompson) officiating in the presence of relatives and friends.
