DEATH OF MR. J. H. GUY. – We regret to announce the death of Mr. John Henry Guy, which occurred on Thursday at his residence, The Retreat, Mount Pleasant, after an illness of about six months' duration. The deceased, who was 59, was the eldest son of the late Mr. Samuel Guy, of Pyle-street. In his early days he was a prominent cyclist and a member of the local club. Leaving the Island for Wimborne, Mr. Guy established there a successful drapery business, and during his residence for about 20 years he was secretary of the Congregational Church. On returning with his wife and family to his native town Mr. Guy was the recipient of a handsome testimonial in appreciation of his faithful service. On returning to Newport Mr. Guy opened a business in the High-street, and relinquished it about two years ago. For several years he filled the office of deacon of the Congregational Church, but failing health had latterly prevented him from taking an active part in the affairs of the church. The deceased leaves a widow and two grown-up sons and daughter, for whom much sympathy is expressed in their sad bereavement. The funeral service will be held at the Congregational Church on Monday.
