OBITUARY. – Much sympathy is felt for Mr. and Mrs. S. Guy, of Pyle-street, in the loss they have sustained by the death on Sunday evening of their daughter, Miss Maude M. Guy, aged 18, from complications attendant on an attack of rheumatic fever, from which she had been suffering for about a fortnight. The fatal termination to her illness was the more distressing as it was hoped she was recovering. Deceased had been connected with the Primitive Methodist Sunday-school from her earliest years, and she was also a valued member of the choir at that place of worship. The funeral took place at Newport Cemetery on Thursday afternoon, in the presence of many sorrowing friends, in addition to the family and other principal mourners. The Rev. George Wood officiated. Those sending floral tributes included the members of the Sunday-school and choir above mentioned.
