DEATH OF MR. W. E. HAZARD. – The death occurred suddenly on Tuesday at his residence, Fairlee-road, of Mr. Walter Edwin Hazard, aged 71. The deceased, who was in the employ of Messrs. Crouchers, Ltd., will be best remembered as formerly a draper at Cowes. He was a clever designer, and on the occasion of the marriage of H.R.H. Princess Beatrice made a model of Whippingham Church, where the ceremony took place, complete in every detail. The designer was honoured by a command from Queen Victoria to attend at Osborne House, and Her Majesty was so pleased with the model that she purchased it, and smaller models were supplied for the ladies-in-waiting. The deceased leaves a widow, three sons, and two daughters. The funeral service will be held at St. Paul's, Barton, on Sunday at 2 o'clock, the interment taking place at Newport Cemetery.
