I.W. Home Guards Killed on Exercise

During an anti-invasion exercise in the Isle of Wight yesterday, two Home Guards, Lieut. Andrew Bull, of Wootton, and Volunteer Beauchamp Killeen, of Fairlee Road, Newport, belonging to Wootton platoon of the Home Guard, were accidentally killed. Killeen was a motor cyclist messenger and Bull was riding pillion when their machine crashed into a Bren gun carrier. They died soon afterwards in a military hospital to which they were taken in an ambulance, which was on a journey to pick up imaginary casualties.

Lieut. Bull was a partner in a well-known Isle of Wight firm of auctioneers.
