NEWPORT

FUNERAL OF A MEMBER OF THE NEWPORT RIFLE VOLUNTEER CORPS. - On Tuesday afternoon the mortal remains of Private William Lambert were buried with military honours in the Newport cemetery. After the deceased's relatives and a troop of private friends in procession, came the Newport company of Rifle Volunteers, Capt. Pittis commanding, the band playing the Dead March in Saul. Mr Durban, Baptist minister, officiated and read a rather long service, which was inaudible to most of the numerous spectators. The volley firing over the grave, under the direction of Serjeant Read, was done with the nicest precision. A strong muster of the deceased's comrades were present to pay their tribute of reverence to the memory of this humble but exemplary citizen soldier.
