DEATH OF MRS. A. GILL MARTIN

It is with great regret that we record the death, yesterday, of Mrs. A. Gill Martin, for more than 20 years mistress of the infants' department of the Newport Board schools. The deceased lady had been for some considerable time in failing health and she resigned her appointment last summer, but it was only during the past fortnight that her illness showed such a serious development as to confine her to her bed. The late Mrs. Martin, with her husband, came to Newport on the occasion of the opening of the Board schools in Upper St. James's-street, and so long as her health and strength enabled her to actively perform the duties of her responsible position, she proved herself an excellent teacher and trainer and maintained her department in a state of efficiency which repeatedly called forth the warm commendation of Government inspectors and the Board. The bereaved husband – the esteemed headmaster of the Newport Board schools – and his son, Dr. Antony Martin, have the deepest sympathy of all in their sorrow.
