NOTED CRICKETER'S DEATH. - The death occurred on Tuesday, at the residence of his relatives in Quay-street, of Mr. George Mew, aged 65, who recently returned to the town after some years' absence, suffering from a painful internal malady, to which he succumbed. Deceased will be remembered as a noted local cricketer of years ago, when for some time he was groundsman of the Newport Club. The funeral took place yesterday (Friday), the first part of the service being at the Parish-church and the interment at the Cemetery. The Rev. J. L. Spratt officiated. The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. A. Mew (brother and sister-in-law), Mr. Alfred Mew (brother), Mr. Arthur Mew (nephew), Mr. and Mrs. Morris (nephew and niece), and Mr. and Mrs. Odell. There were also present Mr. G. Gifford and Mr. H. W. Dore, old cricketing friends. Mr. W. H. Bullock carried out the funeral arrangements.
