MUCH SYMPATHY – has been aroused by the specially sad circumstances of the death of Mrs. Dorothy Hilda Millgate, aged 24, wife of Sergt. Stanley Millgate, M.G.C., and only daughter of Mr. W.H. Bullock, of 15 High-street. The distressing event occurred at the Fairlee Hospital during Friday night last week, only 16 days after her marriage at St. Thomas's Church on the 2nd inst. The honeymoon was spent at Salisbury and Cranleigh, and, after returning home on the 12th inst. deceased developed a serious illness, which she had contracted whilst away. All that medical skill and the best of nursing could do were done, but without avail, and she passed peacefully away as stated. The funeral took place at Newport Cemetery on Monday, the mourners being Sergt. S. Millgate (husband), who is home on leave from active service, Mr. W.H. Bullock (father), Mr. W. Bullock (brother), Mr. W. Coombes (uncle), Mrs. Jones (aunt), Mrs. Millgate (mother-in-law), Miss Millgate and Miss Lizzie Millgate (sisters-in-law), and Mr. Arthur Davis, R.M.L.I. Those sending the numerous floral tributes included the workmen employed by Mr. W.H. Bullock, "With deepest sympathy. Gone a ray of sunshine," Miss Pittis, Miss E.
