DEATH OF MR. ALFRED MILLIDGE

We greatly regret to record the death of an old and much esteemed townsman in the person of Mr Alfred Millidge, of High-street and Carisbrooke-road, who expired suddenly on Wednesday evening. Deceased, who had been medically attended for some time for heart trouble, but continued at business till the end, was on his way from his home to his business premises, when he had a heart attack at the top of Pyle-street. He entered the newspaper shop of Mr. Young, 93 Pyle-street, and asked to be allowed to sit down. He received every attention, and deceased's son and medical attendant were promptly summoned by telephone, but he quickly succumbed, being beyond human aid when the doctor arrived.
