DEATH OF MRS. A. L. MORRIS

The death occurred, at the age of 88, at the Home Hospital, Ryde, on Monday, of Mrs. Ada Leonora Morris, widow of Mr. Henry James Morris, well known in Island farming circles. The wldest daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. George Henton, of Loverstone Farm, Chillerton, Mrs. Morris was born at the farm, and spent the whole of her life on Island farms until she and her husband retired. For several years her husband was manager of Whitecroft Hospital farm. He then entered into partnership with his wife's brother, Mr. Hilton Henton, in farming Appuldurcombe Farm, Wroxall, and after Mr. Henton emigrated to New Zealand, remained at Appuldurcombe.

On retiring Mr. and Mrs. Morris took up residence at Utopia, Staplers, Newport, and after her husband's death just over seven years ago Mrs. Morris had lived at the Home Hospital. There are no children. While living at Wroxall Mrs. Morris took a keen interest in the Methodist Church. The funeral took place at Quay Street Methodist Church, Newport, yesterday.
