OBITUARY. – We record with regret the death of Mrs. F. E. Parsons, widow of Mr. R. J. Parsons, who passed away at Redoubt Villa, Freshwater, the residence of her sister, yesterday week, after three months; painful illness. The late Mrs. Parsons was formerly a well-known and highly-esteemed resident of Newport, having lived for some 20 years at Rose Villa, Union-street. The funeral took place at Newport on Thursday, the first part of the service being performed at St. Thomas's Church, and the interment was at Newport Cemetery, where the deceased's lady's husband and eldest son have their last resting-place. The rector of Freshwater impressively officiated at the last solemn offices at the grave. There were a number of beautiful floral memorial tributes.
