#### NEWPORT.

**DEATH AFTER WAR SERVICE.** – The funeral took place on Thursday at Newport Cemetery, the vicar (Rev. C. H. Thompson) officiating, of Mr. George Phillips, aged 35, of Sea-street, who died on Sunday from pulmonary tuberculosis. An Army Reservist, when war broke out, he went with the 2<sup>nd</sup> Suffolks in the First Army to France and fought at Mons (for which he had the star) and in the subsequent engagements until invalided home with consumption just before Christmas, 1914. He was invalided out of the Army in June. He leaves a widow and five young children, for whom much sympathy is felt.
