NEWPORT.

A SALVATION ARMY FUNERAL – took place at the Newport Cemetery on Tuesday afternoon, the deceased being Mrs. E. Rugg, aged 63, of Orchard-street, who had been a member of the local corps for a number of years, and who died on Friday last. The proceedings were of the usual impressive nature, the cortege being preceded by the band, which, under the direction of Mr. Ogden, played a familiar hymn as a funeral march on the way to the Cemetery and suitable music at the grave, where hymns were sung. Ensign and Mrs. Clayson officiated, assisted by Ensign Allen. The mourners, outside of those of the family, were chiefly female members of the Army, some of whom walked by the side of the hearse.
