Death of Mrs. J. W. Stanley.—A lady who was noted for her fruitfulness in good works passed away yesterday in the person of Mrs. Stanley, wife of Mr. J. W. Stanley, J.P., who will have the sincere sympathy of his many Island friends in the terrible blow which has befallen him. It seems that Mr. and Mrs. Stanley left home on Thursday week to spend the week-end with Mrs. Marden, the latter's sister, at Bishop's Stortford. She was taken ill on Saturday and her illness developed into pneumonia and other complications. On Thursday the invalid's condition justified Mr. Stanley's return to the Island, but yesterday morning he was called back by telegram, and unfortunately was unable to reach the bedside in time to see the end. Amongst the many beneficent institutions which Mrs. Stanley assisted by her exertions and her purse were the Rescue and Preventative Society, the Dorcas Society, the Newport Benevolent Society, St. Thomas's Schools, and Dr. Barnardo's Houses. To the local workers on behalf of these last the kindly lady had recently promised the use of her grounds for their annual sale of work. The funeral will take place on Tuesday next, the first part of the service at St. Thomas's Church at 2.30 p.m.
