DEATH OF MR. F. STANLEY. – Much sympathy is felt for Mrs. Stanley, of the Shoulder of Mutton Inn, in the death on Saturday of her much respected husband, Mr. Fred Stanley, aged 41, who had been the licensee of that house since October. Deceased came here from Doncaster some nine years ago, and was an engine fitter at the I.W. Central Railway Company's works until the state of his health compelled him to relinquish that employment. He had been in bad health for about four years, and was in bed for some seven months before his death. He leaves a widow and one little daughter. The funeral took place at Newport Cemetery on Tuesday, following a service at the Parish Church, the Rev. Canon Thompson officiating.
