DEATH OF MR.A. UPWARD. – On Friday last, Mr. Alfred Upward, of the firm of Messrs. E.J. Upward and Co., died at his residence, Broadlands-terrace, at the early age of 38, after a short illness. Mr. Upward, who was very much esteemed, was buried at Newport Cemetery on Monday, when most of the tradesmen of Newport, to show their respect for his character, put up their shutters. After a short religious service at the house of the deceased, the coffin was borne to the Cemetery by the *employes* of the firm. The chief mourners were the four brothers of the deceased, Messrs. E.J., G., F., and I. Upward. A considerable number of friends joined the funeral procession. The funeral service was read by the deceased's pastor, the Rev. M. Newland. Mr. Upward has left a widow, but no family..
