OCTOGENARIAN'S DEATH. – The death took place on Sunday of Mr. John Walton, 83, of Crocker-street, who was for 48 years employed in the brewer's department of the Royal Brewery, and was much esteemed by employers and employed. In his early days he served in the Royal Navy on H.M.S. The Queen and was a very smart sailor. He was a collector of photos and pictures of wooden warships in full sail and was very fond of flowers. After being superannuated by the Royal Brewery firm, owing to old age, he was very grateful to the firm for granting him his full wages ever since he was unfit for work, as well as for many other kindnesses from that firm. His daughter was his sole companion in his declining years. The funeral took place yesterday (Friday) afternoon, the first part of the service being at the Parish-church where the Rev. C.C. Sharpe officiated. Some of the Royal Brewery employes attended the funeral. Floral tributes were sent by the members of the firm and by the staff and employes.
