#### DEATH AT NEWPORT OF DR ALLAN WATERWORTH

With great regret we record the death of Dr. E. Allan Waterworth, which occurred at his residence, Newport, yesterday (Friday) at the age of 53. The deceased belonged to a well-known medical family, three generations of whom had practiced in Newport and the Isle of Wight. The late Dr. Allan Waterworth held several offices identified with the public life of the Island. For just upon a quarter of a century he was the medical officer of the Isle of Wight Workhouse, the important duties of which he continued to discharge until a week before his death. When his health began to seriously fail him about a year ago he was granted leave of absence by the Guardians, who, whilst thus showing their sympathy with him, gave expression to the regard which they entertained for the officer who had served them so long and so faithfully. For many years he had been closely identified with the work of friendly societies in Newport, as surgeon of Court Island Foresters and also of the female and juvenile courts since established in connection with local Forestry; and of the Shepherds, whose only hon. Member he was. For some years the late Dr. Waterworth was Surgeon-Major in the Isle of Wight Militia Artillery, succeeding his father, the late Mr. Henry Waterworth, who for some 20 years held a commission in that regiment. Among other offices which deceased had served was that of churchwarden of the parish-church of Newport. He was held in warm esteem by a wide circle of friends, by whom his death is greatly deplored, and their deepest sympathy will be with Mrs. Waterworth and her family in their sorrow.
