DEATH OF MR. GEORGE H. WATERWORTH. – We regret to record the death, which took place at 90, Upper St. James's-street on Wednesday evening, at the age of 60, of Mr. George Henry Waterworth. As the oldest son of the late Mr. Henry Waterworth, F.R.C.S., J.P., the deceased was connected with an old and esteemed Isle of Wight family. He was a remarkably intelligent and well-read man, and an excellent French and German scholar. For many years he was a very valued member of the Island Rifle Volunteers, in which he held the rank of quarter-master-sergeant for some years before his retirement. He rendered specially useful service in this capacity and in the establishment of a class for instruction in Army signalling, and he wore the long-service medal. He had held several appointments in the town, including those of assistant overseer of the parish of Newport and collector of the Newport Gas Company, and he was a familiar figure at the Parish-church and a devoted helper to the officers of the church. The funeral takes place this (Saturday) afternoon, the service at the Parish-church being fixed for 3 p.m.
