THE LATE MR. H. INNES WILKINS. – The funeral of the late Mr. Henry Innes Wilkins, whose death was recorded in last week's *County Press*, took place on Monday afternoon at Newport Cemetery. The deceased, who was the youngest son of the late Dr. E. P. Wilkins, of this town, was by profession a solicitor, but of late years had not practiced. He had been in indifferent health for some time past, but his death came as a shock and surprise to his numerous friends. The first portion of the burial service was held at the parish church, the Rev. Miles Atkinson officiating. The principal mourners were Miss Wilkins (sister), the Rev. C. Wilkins and Dr. Meers (uncles), Mr. Arthur F. Wilson, Mr. C. Turner Clark, Mr. J. T. Moore, and Mr. C. E. Nobbs, and among others present were Miss Fullagar, Miss Gray, Mr. W. H. The coffin plate bore the inscription: "Henry Innes Wilkins, died July 7th, 1898, aged 42 years."
