The Late Mr. A. J. Frost.----The death occurred at his home, 18 School Lane, Barton, on Tuesday, of Mr. Albert John Frost, aged 69. During the first world war he served in the Navy at Malta and retired on pension in 1921 as a chief petty officer after 21 years` service. He was employed by Messrs. Groves and Guttridge at East Cowes until 10 years ago, when his health deteriorated. He was a keen member of the Princess Royal Inn darts team until a year ago and was fond of gardening. Mr. Frost was a member of the Tunbridge Wells Equitable Society. Sympathy is felt with his wife, son, and daughter. The funeral took place at St. Paul`s on Thursday, a service in the church being conducted by the Vicar (the Rev. L. J. D. Wheatley). The mourners were Mrs. L. Frost (widow), Mr. and Mrs. D. Morley (son-in-law and daughter), Mr. and Mrs. A. J. Frost (son and daughter-in-law), Mr. F. Frost (brother), and Mr. and Mrs. W Symes (representing the Tunbridge Wells Equitable Society).
