The Late Mr. F. G. Henderson.— The funeral service took place at St. Paul's Church on Wednesday week for Mr. Frederick George Henderson, aged 73, of 20 Highfield Road, who died suddenly at St. Mary's Hospital on March 5th. Mr. Henderson, whose father had been chief coastguard in the Island, had spent much of his life at sea with the Union Castle Line. After leaving the company in 1935 he worked first for the Corporation and then for Messrs. Morris's Stores, retiring 11 years ago. He had been chairman of Newport Toc H. The Rev. W. Boardman officiated. The mourners were Mrs. S. W. Henderson (widow), Mr. and Mrs. H. G. Henderson (son and daughter-in-law), Miss J. N. Henderson (daughter), Miss L. I. A. Henderson (grand-daughter), Mrs. J. Crisp (sister), Mrs. V. Henderson (sister-in-law), Mr. N. C. Arnold (brother-in-law), Mr. and Mrs. N. Henderson, Mrs. A. Henderson, and Mr. L. Arnold (nephew and nieces). Mr. P. Henderson (brother) and Mrs. H. Warder (sister) were unable to attend. Interment was at St. Paul's Cemetery. Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son made the arrangements.
