The Late Mrs. G. Horton.--The death occurred at the Royal I.W. County Hospital on Sunday week of Mrs. Gertrude Horton, of Dunromin, 52 Barton Road. Mrs. Horton, who came from Worcester in 1930, was well-known as a member of the Victoria Sisterhood and as a whist player. She is survived by two daughters. The funeral service took place at St. Paul's Church on Thursday week, conducted by the Vicar (the Rev. L. J. D. Wheatley). The hymns "O God our help in ages past" and "Abide with me" were accompanied by Miss A. Trenchard (organist). The mourners were Mr. I. Thomson and Mrs. G. Lillywhite (son-in-law and daughter), Messrs. Kenneth and Keith Lillywhite (grandsons), Mr. T. Lillywhite and Mesdames W. Wareham, J. Carver, and L. Brett. Mrs. I. Thomson (daughter) and Mrs. K.
