The Late Mr. A. L. Kemp. – The death occurred on Tuesday of Arthur Leonard Kemp, aged 73, of 2 Hillside. Mr. Kemp was born in the town and started in business as a wholesale fruit and vegetable merchant. Later he became a retail coal merchant and retired several years ago. In his younger days he was well known as a pigeon and rabbit fancier, having won several prizes. His wife died in January last year and he is survived by two sons and a daughter. The funeral took place yesterday, the service at St. Paul's Church being conducted by the Vicar (the Rev. L. J. D. Wheatley). The mourners were Mr. V. D. Kemp (son), Mrs. D. Rawlings (daughter), and Mr. and Mrs. R. McCaughan. The interment followed at St. Paul's Cemetery. Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son made the arrangements.
