Death of Mrs. E. L. Mew. – The death occurred at Ladylands on Friday week of Mrs. Emma Louisa Mew, formerly of Royal Exchange, Newport, aged 86, a much esteemed resident of Newport, she was the widow of Mr. Charles Mew, a stone dresser, who was employed at the Medina Mills, and who died about 12 years ago. Mrs. Mew was a regular worshipper at St. Paul's Church, where she took a keen interest in the Mothers' Union. The funeral service at St. Paul's Church on Tuesday was conducted by the Vicar (the Rev. T. L. Kimber). The hymns, "Jesu, Lover of my soul," and "Abide with me," were accompanied by Mr. L. E. Dore (organist). The mourners were Messrs. W., H., J. Mew (sons), Mr. and Mrs. J.
