Shipyard Worker's Sudden Death.--Mr. Albert Henry Thompson, aged 56, a single man living alone at 14 Royal-exchange, died suddenly while on his way home from his work as a labourer at a Cowes shipyard on Thursday evening. After coming from Cowes by train he was found in Sea-street suffering with severe pains in the chest by Mr. W. Rackett, of 55 Hunnyhill, who, at Thompson's request, helped him to the Prince Regent Inn. Here the licensee gave him a sip of brandy, but shortly afterwards he collapsed, and was dead when Dr. Foster arrived. He is understood to have been suffering from heart trouble for several years.
