Sudden Death. — The death occurred suddenly at his home, 51 Ash Road, on Sunday, of Mr. George Henry Hayter, aged 74. Mr. Hayter, who had been in reasonably good health, was standing beside his wireless set, when he collapsed and died. He was born at Royal Exchange, and on leaving school became a mariner, working for Crouchers, Ltd. from 1902 to 1927, and by Messrs. Pickfords, who took over the firm, until 1946, when he retired. He retired at the age of 65, and spent most of his time in his favourite hobby of gardening. Mr. Hayter is survived by his wife, one son, and four daughters. The funeral took place on Thursday, a service at the house, conducted by Major Boniface, of the Salvation Army, being followed by interment at St. Paul's Cemetery. Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son made the arrangements.
