Death of Mrs. B. Leigh. – Her numerous friends in the town heard with deep regret of the death at 58 Victoria-road, on Wednesday, of Mrs. Mabel Ada Leigh, the wife of Mr. Bertie Leigh. Mrs. Leigh, who was only 48, had been ill since September, but her passing occurred unexpectedly, and much sympathy is felt with her husband, a clerk at the Royal Brewery. Mrs. Leigh had been sick pay officer of the Lady Adela Cochrane Lodge of Oddfellows for eight years, and her cherry disposition and kindly manner admirably suited her for this work. She was a Past N.G. of the lodge. She was also a member of the Barton Women's Institute. The funeral will take place to-day (Saturday) at St. Paul's Church at 2 p.m.
