FATAL ACCIDENT. – Sympathy is felt with Mrs. Lockyer, of Bank Cottage, Barton, in the accidental death of her youngest son, Leonard Lockyer, aged 19, a mariner on one of Messrs. Croucher's vessels, who was fatally crushed on the vessel at Southampton, by the slipping of a heavy weight which was being raided by a crane. At the inquest a verdict of accidental death was returned. He was the only son left at home, two others being on active service in the Army. The interment took place at St. Paul's, Barton, in the presence of representatives of the deceased's employers and many fellow workmen, who have shown practical sympathy with the mother.
