Died at the County Hospital. – The death took place in the County Hospital on Tuesday week of Mr. Donald Osborne, son of Mr. and Mrs. G. Osborne, of 6 School-lane. The deceased, who was only 17, had been employed at Messrs. Mew Langton's Royal Brewery and was a member of the Home Guard. The funeral was on Saturday, when the Rev. H. G. Kelsey officiated. Six members of the Home Guard acted as bearers and the coffin was covered with the Union Jack. The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. G. Osborne (father and mother), Bomdr. D. Osborne (brother), Mrs. Aldous and Mr. and Mrs. Davis (sisters and brother-in-law), Mr. and Mrs. J., Mr. and Mrs. C., and Driver B. Clarke (stepbrother and step-sisters-in-law), and Mr. and Mrs. B. Gustar and Mr. C. Haines (uncles and aunt). Members of the staff of the Royal Brewery and of the Home Guard attended. There were about 40 floral tributes. The arrangements were carried out by Messrs. Hamilton and Son.
